# Why EEGI Labelling?

- The EEGI Label acknowledges that a specific project is **in line with the spirit of the EEGI** (i.e. knowledge sharing of results, system level innovation, etc.) and an EEGI Functional Objective as specified in the *EEGI Research and Innovation Roadmap*.
- Provides a methodology for identifying the list of **projects that form part of the EEGI Roadmap**.
- EEGI Labelling can form the **basis for setting up future projects** and issues of special interest to tackle.

# Why EEGI Labelling?

- EEGI Label can provide **additional visibility** to smart Grids projects

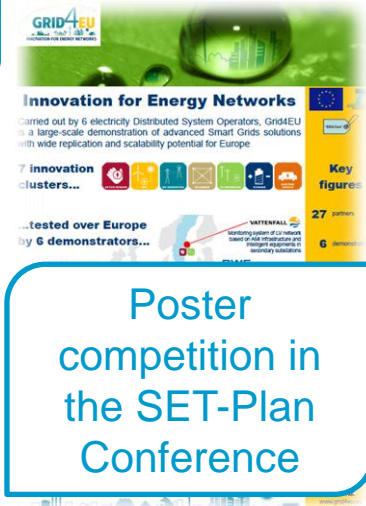

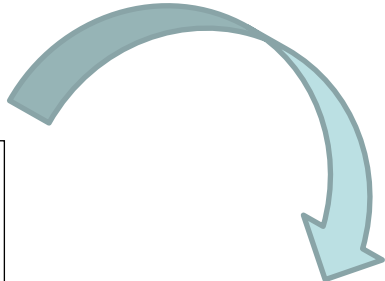

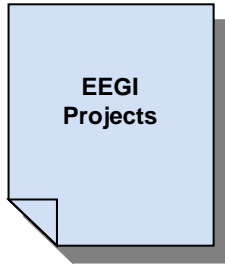

# Three EEGI Labels have been defined



- Fully in line with criteria specified in EEGI Labeling Process
- Fully in line with the EEGI objectives, form the core of the EEGI Programme
- System-level innovation
- In case of DSO projects: large-scale demo projects



- Basic EEGI requirements satisfied
- Typically involve smaller projects with demonstrations of individual technologies
- **Not applicable to TSO projects**

- Projects that do not satisfy criteria necessary for “EEGI Core” or “EEGI Support” projects

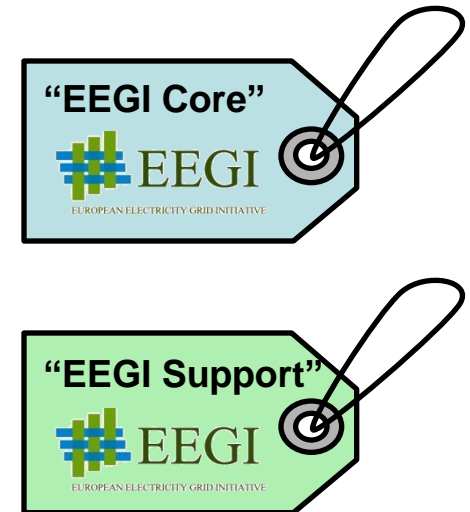
